The mileage rate increased to \$.67/mi January 1, 2024.

Schultz discussed the update to the Le Sueur County Well Sealing Grant Policy. Le Sueur County has funds available to cost-share 100% of well sealing projects. The SWCD can partner with the county so landowners can receive 100% cost-share rather than 50% which is the current SWCD policy.

The courthouse remodeling is about 3 weeks behind schedule due to rainfall and internet line issues. Road construction and seal coating were also discussed.

NRCS – Steve Breaker and Kim Scheffler are completing site inspections, attending training and working on CRP plans.

FSA – Taylor Carlson informed the board that County Committee elections are coming up if they know of a qualified candidate to file.

SWCD Business

Earle Traxler attended the Area 6 meeting in Hutchinson. South Central Service Coop partnering with SWCD's for HR services was discussed. Le Sueur SWCD will be hosting the fall Area 6 meeting.

Mike and Sue attended administrative training in Baxter, MN. Training included tree sales, quickbooks, retirement investing options and round table discussions.

The SWCD lease with the USDA ends July 31, 2024. Mike and Sue are working on renewing the lease. The USDA is offering a 5-year renewal at \$16.50/sq ft which has been the same amount for the past 13 years. Mike would like to rearrange some space within the building before signing a new lease. Other upgrades were discussed such as a new roof, painting the walls and putting in new flooring. USDA will be contacted again to see if any solutions are reachable, and information will be brought to the board at the August meeting.

Letters addressed to Marty Shambour and the Pikal Family LLC will be sent out explaining the future handling of their drainage issues. The SWCD has worked to provide solutions to them and with none being reached, the matter will need to be dealt with privately from now on.

Joe explained an opportunity through a TSA Soil Health Grant that would allow for peer to peer mentoring of landowners wishing to receive more experience in soil health. Mentors could receive payments up to \$3000.00.

Mike went through drone footage of the flooding in the county.

Joe discussed a soil health grant for equipment that would fund 50% up to \$45,000 and borrower needs to be in the MN Ag Water Quality Certification Program.
